EDVOS empowers women to make informed choices through our broad range of programs and services which are individualised and sensitive. Our highly trained staff provide support, advice, information, case management, safety planning, community education, programs for pet safety and a strong network of referral pathways to other services that can assist.

Membership

EDVOS is a feminist community-based agency. Women that live, work or study in the EDVOS region are eligible to apply to be members.

Membership of EDVOS entitles women to participate in General Meetings, and nominate for positions on the Board. The Membership elects a Board of Management at the Annual General Meeting. The Board governs EDVOS and appoints an Chief Executive Officer to provide a wide range of services. Active participation contributes directly to the work done by EDVOS for the women and children of the Eastern metropolitan region.

Membership is renewed annually prior to 30th June.
