Family Violence Training for Salon Professionals

Why salon professionals?

In Australia, two women die every 10 days due to family violence. Research shows that many women establish close relationships with their salon professionals and confide in them about the violence or controlling behaviour they are experiencing at home. A project of Eastern Domestic Violence Service (EDVOS), HaiR-3R's is an internationally evidence-informed family violence training for salon professionals to learn how to spot signs of family violence in their clients, respond and refer them on to a family violence service where they can get the help and support they need.

What we cover

Our free 3-hour interactive workshop is open to salon professionals and hair & beauty students across Australia. The workshop teaches salon professionals how to:

-  Understand the link between gender inequality and family violence;
-  Engage in conversations that challenge community attitudes that reinforce gender inequality;
-  Recognise, respond and refer on family violence disclosures to the appropriate services.



400 salon professionals have been trained to date

87% of salon professionals felt more confident in recognising, responding and referring on disclosures of family violence
